## Sports Premium Analysis for Rudheath Primary Academy

In the academic year 2015-2016 the academy received £9050 Sports Premium Funding. We used this funding to:

- Securing our continuing partnership with the Vale Royal School Sports
  Partnership. This enabled us to train staff in Dance, PE, Gym and Outdoor
  activities as well as having access to a variety of training and events.
- Providing additional sports clubs during and after school. These clubs will be run by external bodies and allow additional extra-curricular activities to occur for all children in school (KS1 and KS2). A significant number of after school clubs have run over the year. The number of clubs available has enabled all children in school (from Reception -> Y6) to take part in at least two clubs over the year. This will be further developed next year.
- Improving the provision of equipment available at school for sport. New equipment has been purchased over the year to enable all areas of gymnastics to be taught.
- Involving the academy in more Cheshire and Vale Royal Tournaments. It also allowed us to take part in a number of inter-school competitions mainly based at UCAN. When successful it also allowed us to move through to Cheshire finals.
- Providing training for teachers to ensure the highest quality lessons. Gymnastic training has taken place for all staff over the last two years funded by the Sports premium.
