Schools and academies receive additional funding for any pupils who have been eligible for free school meals during the last six years; pupils who are looked after by the local authority or who are in care and for pupils from families where a parent serves in the armed forces. This money is known as the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG).

During the academic year 2012-2013, 62 pupils were eligible for funding and we received £37140

This money was spent on providing:
